**SECOND JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND BRIEFING
SCHEDULE REGARDING TILDA, LTD.’S MOTION FOR RELIEF
FROM, OR MODIFICATION TO, COMMON BENEFIT FUND ORDER**

Plaintiffs’ Court-appointed Co-Lead Counsel (“Lead Counsel”) and Plaintiffs’ Executive Committee, on behalf of themselves and other plaintiffs’ counsel who, at the direction, request, and supervision of Lead Counsel actively have assisted in prosecuting this centralized multidistrict litigation (the “Leadership Group”) and Tilda, Ltd. (“Tilda”), jointly move to extend the deadlines for the briefing schedule pertaining to Tilda’s Motion for Relief From, or Modification to, Common Benefit Fund Order (D.I. 3588) (the “Tilda Motion”). The Court granted a two week extension on November 4, 2010 (D.I. 3622) making the Leadership Group’s memorandum in opposition to the Tilda Motion due no later than Friday, November 19, 2010 and Tilda’s reply memorandum due no later than Friday, December 3, 2010. The parties request a second extension because issues that directly implicate the pending motion may be raised at the status conference on November 18, 2010. The agreed extensions, subject to the Court’s approval, are as follows:

1. The Leadership Group’s memorandum in opposition to the Tilda Motion shall be filed no later than **Friday, December 3, 2010**.

2. Tilda's reply memorandum shall be filed no later than **Friday, December 17, 2010.**

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the parties respectfully request that the foregoing Second Joint Motion to Extend Briefing Schedule be granted.
